This weekend!
FAIR TRADE SALE AT ST. JAMES

The Good Shepherd Central America Group, which includes some St. James parishioners, will be holding a Fair Trade Sale at St. James after all Masses on the weekend of **December 11th & 12th**. Items for purchase will include fair trade coffee, chocolate bars, cocoa, and olive oil in addition to numerous hand-made wooden crafts, jewelry and leather goods from El Salvador.

Good Shepherd has had a sistering relationship with the Salvadoran Village of Ella Curia since 1990 when two Good Shepherd members went on a delegation to the village while the country was still in the midst of a Civil War. Since that time several delegations have made the trip including St. James parishioners Ed Schlumpf (twice) and Bob Schuelke (once).

Since it was formed, the Central America Group has assisted its Sister Community in acquiring land, building houses, obtaining clean drinking water, building a school, paying teachers, establishing child care and building a church. Proceeds from the Fair Trade Sale are used to help in these efforts.

The village takes its name from Fr. Ignacio Ella Curia, a Spanish Jesuit who was one of six brutally murdered priests that taught at the University of El Salvador. Many other were killed including Archbishop Oscar Romero, recently canonized as a saint by the Vatican.

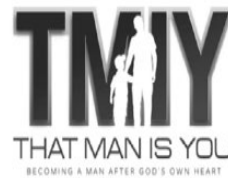
Scripture Reflection Groups

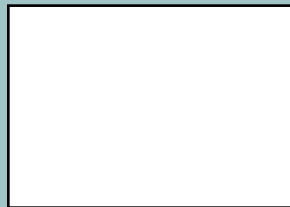

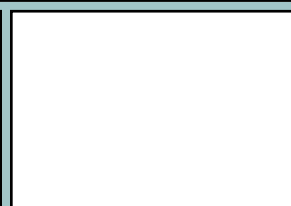
